Her feature documentary Made in L.A. was praised by The New York Times as "an excellent documentary... about basic human dignity," and won an Emmy, the Henry Hampton Award from the Council on Foundations and the Hillman Prize for Broadcast Journalism. Carracedo previously directed the short documentary Welcome, A Docu-Journey of Impressions, which won the Sterling Award at Silverdocs. She frequently lectures at universities and is one of the professors at IPECC's Master of Documentary Production and Direction of the University of Alcalá in Madrid.

Robert Bahar is an Emmy-winning documentary filmmaker, producer and writer. Robert, a Creative Capital Fellow, has dedicated more than a decade to documentary education through Doculink, a community of 4,000 documentarians that he co-founded and directed for ten years. He is the Producer/Writer of the Emmywinning feature documentary Made in L.A., which screened internationally at 100+ film festivals.
